Background: Each English abstract must be in Word 2010 or higher file format. An abstract of 250-350 words should be provided to state the reason for the study, the main findings and the conclusions drawn from the observation. Abstract of original articles and brief reports should be structured under the following headings: Background, Objectives, Materials/Patients and Methods, Results and Conclusions. This section should summarize the purpose and the rationale for the study. It should neither review the subject extensively nor should it have data or conclusions of the study.

Objectives: Author(s) should declare objectives/aims of the study.

Materials/Patients and Methods: This should include exact method or observation or experiment. If an apparatus is used, its manufacturer's name and address should be given in parenthesis. If the method is established, give reference but if the method is new, give enough information so that another author is able to perform it. If a drug is used, its generic name, dose and route of administration must be given. Statistical method must be mentioned and specify any general computer program used. The info system used should be clearly mentioned.

Results: It must be presented in the form of text, tables and illustrations. The contents of the tables should not be all repeated in the text. Instead, a reference to the table number may be given. Long articles may need sub-headings within some sections (especially the Results and Discussion parts) to clarify their contents. Article title font is Times New Roman 14pt Bold. Choose a title that is long enough to cover the main points and by considering the importance of shortness. Only the first letter of the first word of each title and also abbreviations should be in upper case.

Conclusion: Avoid context and reference figure in the abstract. Name the author(s) respectively, indicating the effectiveness of the plan with font Times New roman 12pt Bold. Abstract should be prepared by Times New Roman font size 12pt. Place it with a distance of between 90mm and 120mm from top of the page. Keyword font should

be prepared by Times New Roman 12pt Bold. Keywords should be minimum 3 and maximum 5 words separated by comma. Single line spacing after each paragraph 6 pt are selected and considered. A4 size page's margin should be approximately equal to up and down 25 mm, right 30mm and left 35 mm. The abstract should be written in a single column. Abstracts that are not in this form will not be considered.
